Palma, 1 December 2021 – Endesa has renewed its collaboration with the publication of the 2020 Ornithological Yearbook of the Balearic Islands (volume 35), a support that, once again, shows Endesa's commitment to the environment and the preservation of nature and native species. The Company, within Endesa's Sustainability Plan in the Balearic Islands, maintains its constancy in this commitment, since it has been carrying out this collaboration for 29 years.

The presentation of the 35th volume of the Yearbook was held today at 12.00 pm in the lagoon of Es Forcadets, located within the Natural Park of the Albufera de Mallorca. 30 hectares of land located within the Natural Park of the Albufera de Mallorca, which was the subject of the signing of a Land Stewardship Agreement (ACT), signed by the Ministry of Environment, Agriculture and Fisheries of the Balearic Islands, Endesa and the GOB.

The lagoon is connected to a whole series of ditches and canals (the longest of which was dredged in 2016, being also one of the priority actions contemplated within the ACT), which has made it possible for the waters of the lagoon to be properly renewed and thus allow a greater presence of aquatic flora and fauna.

Today's presentation ceremony was attended by the coordinator of the GOB, Antoni Muñoz, the head of the Ornithology area of the GOB, Manuel Suárez, and the general director of Endesa in the Balearic Islands, Martí Ribas.

It is necessary to remember the prestige, within the scientific field, of the Ornithological Yearbook of the Balearic Islands, and the recognition it has received in previous years within the Latindex project, in the III Workshop on obtaining bibliometric indicators and scientific activity.
