SAFETY PROTOCOL FOR ENDESA'S 2022 EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL SHAREHOLDERS' MEETING

Physical attendance by shareholders (or their representatives) at the General Shareholders' Meeting could be hindered or restricted by measures in force on the date of the meeting to ensure the general interest and preserve the health of shareholders, employees and other participants in the preparation and holding of the General Shareholders' Meeting. For this reason, and in order to promote the event's feasibility, Endesa's Board of Directors recommends remote participation, through vote or proxy representation by means of remote communication or telematic attendance.

In any case, any shareholders or their representatives who, despite the recommendation to participate remotely still wish to attend the General Meeting in person, should bear in mind that, in order to access the venue for the Meeting at Endesa's registered office, they should comply with the security protocol published on the website (www.endesa.com) and that the above-mentioned protocol may be modified before the date of the General Meeting in view of any additional measures that may come into force that would restrict the capacity or the maximum number of people who may attend the General Meeting at the venue, or that in any way may restrict the physical attendance of shareholders and their representatives at this General Meeting.

Notwithstanding the above, the Company reserves the right to make any modifications to this protocol that may be appropriate in view of any concurrent circumstances or legal changes that may occur.

Access to the building

- Given the expected high number of attendees at the Shareholders' Meeting and even though mask wearing is no longer mandatory indoors, it is recommended to wear a mask during the meeting. If you do not have a mask of these characteristics, the Company will make them available to shareholders and their representatives.
- You should plan to arrive at the venue with plenty of time to spare to avoid crowds.
- To avoid crowds, you will need about an hour to present your accreditation.
- In compliance with the applicable legislation, once the capacity established by the competent authorities has been exceeded, no further access to the premises where the General Meeting is held will be allowed.

Inside the building

- The cleaning and disinfection of the installations are guaranteed.
- It is recommended that you wear a mask that covers your nose and mouth and it should be kept on at all times.
- Stairs should be used rather than lifts as far as possible. The latter should be used only in case of need or physical limitation and there will be preferential use for people with reduced mobility.
- The access and exit will be undertaken in an orderly manner, following the existing signs and any indications given by the organisation's staff.
- The shareholders should make speeches in the places enabled for this purpose, and the equipment will be disinfected after each speech.
- Once the event has finished, you should remain seated. In accordance with the indications given by members of the organisation, participants will leave the auditorium in an orderly manner and without crowding.
